



UC Davis Distinctions:

- Ranked 10th in research funding among all U.S. public universities, receiving \$586 million in 2007-08.
- A leader in energy research with more than 100 faculty engaged in research and academic programs, including renewable energy, biofuels, efficiency, hydrogen pathways, transportation and lighting technology.
- UC Davis leads the nation in graduate and undergraduate education in the biological sciences. Year after year, UC Davis tops the charts in numbers of doctoral and bachelor's degrees conferred.
- Research at UC Davis has fueled the growth of the \$45 billion-a-year California wine industry. The campus was honored by an Assembly Resolution of the California Legislature for its worldwide leadership and innovation in enology and viticulture.
- Ranked fourth of all U.S. institutions hosting international scholars in 2007-08 (2,543).
- Attracted over 4,500 international scholars and students from 110 countries in 2006-07 and tripled study abroad participation since 2000.
- Offers a broad range of innovative global study experiences for over 1,300 of our undergraduates annually.
- Invested over \$1 million in bold ideas for outreach and international programs in 45 countries which generated \$19 million in external funding.
- Hosts the Hubert H. Humphrey Fellowship Program (one of only 15 U.S. universities).
- Created 24 international alumni groups in six continents.
