- Monitor the development of the Online Linguistic Support Tool in Erasmus+
- Share best practices on the implementation of joint programmes and joint degrees including quality issues, accreditation and mobility
- Share best practices in international student services including grant schemes
- Organization of one or more joint seminars with other task force(s) on educational innovations and internationalization of teaching and learning
- Contribute to the discussion on the new Coimbra Group structure to sustain and increase the effectiveness of the network
