Introduction

In the framework of ICMED, a project co-financed by European Commission, Erasmus+ KA2 – Capacity building in the Field of Higher Education, the Coimbra Group is looking for **an expert trainer in ICM** (International Credit Mobility) among its members. The selected trainer will deal with the 3rd training week (TW) foreseen by the project ICMED. As a trainer, you will handle these issues related to the International Credit Mobility:

TW3: Recognition mechanisms and instruments within ICM

- Hassan Premier University, Settat, Morocco, 26th 28th November, 2018
 - ECT system versus noncredit based systems & national grading;
 - Recognition of the main instruments & supporting documents (Course Catalogue: LA; ToR; ECTS);
 - Monitoring of the recognition process at HEI level;
 - Recognition of the staff activities;
 - Good practices to achieve flexibility in recognition;
 - Case studies in recognition.

We are looking for candidates who have:

- Knowledge and experience on topics covered by the training (minimum of 5 years);
- Very good organizational skills and are able to work in a multicultural environment;
- Very good interpersonal skills with the ability to develop effective working relationships with people trained;
- > A high sense of responsibility and initiative;
- Excellent command of English and French;
- Knowledge of and experience in handing with projects within Mediterranean Countries.

The candidate should be employed by one of the Coimbra Group member Universities.

Financial matters

Fees for trainer is 214 EUR per day, gross amount plus 120 EUR per day of SUBSISTENCE COSTS (including accommodation). If selected, all the details including ICMED rules, deadlines, tasks and conditions will be stated in the contract between the trainer and the Coimbra Group. Travel costs and visa costs (if any) are covered within the travel costs limits of 275 EUR.

Procedures and Criteria for Selection

Selection will be transparent and fair. No social or religious or gender-based discrimination will be made. The selected candidate will be contacted via Skype to establish the necessary documentation for the program. (S)he will also receive support to deal with logistical aspects, as well as the necessary information regarding the activities abroad.



Rights and Obligations

The beneficiary undertakes to:

- Respect the deadlines indicated by the Coimbra Group;
- Provide the documents related to the mobility and the materials related to the training within the indicated times before, during, and after the training activities;
- Carry out the foreseen activities;
- ➤ Have a valid visa (eventually) and a valid passport upon departure.

The beneficiary has the right to:

- Receive the necessary information and support before, during and after the activities;
- Receive the grant amounts according to the times indicated;
- Have the necessary support during the training abroad.
