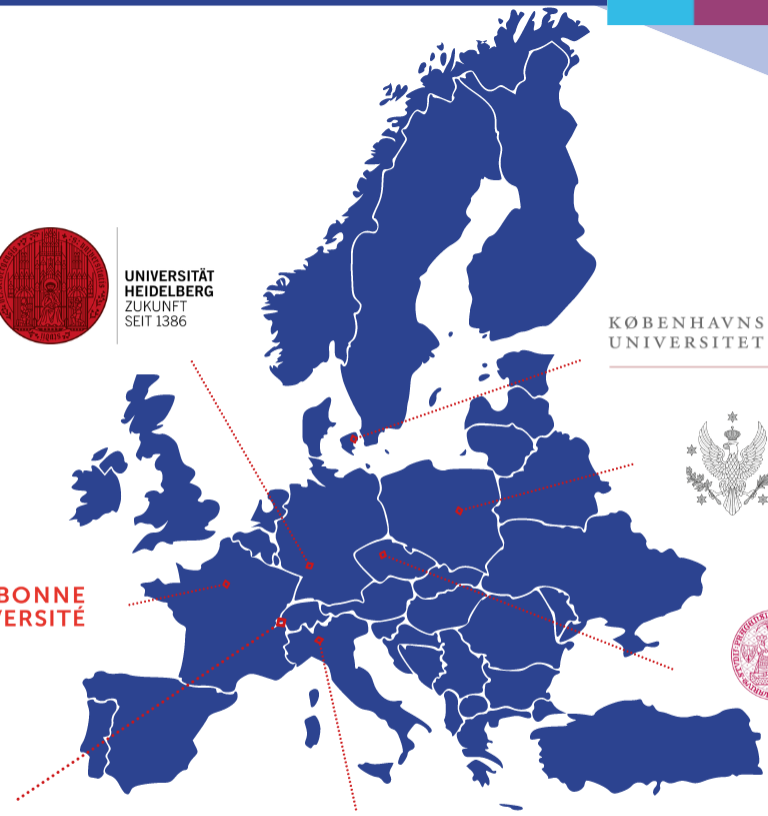

# Internationalization at home



Institution building – not project driven but the Mission driven

Legal entity: Joint Governance

Governing Board, Management Committee, WGs, Flagships

Project Management

= basis for international cooperation

Emphasis is placed on "in-house" internationalization across the institutions

UNIGE's contribution allows for a unique internationalization approach

4EU+ extends beyond the EU, opening doors to a different form of internationalization with IOs

Educational and future research projects foster international collaboration

The proposal BRIDGE4EU+ includes the United Nations Environment Programme as an associated partner

Emphasis is on the specific approach of 4EU+: widening circle, bottom-up collaboration, and leveraging strengths together

## Eastern Partnership University Cluster Initiative

## Eastern Partnership and 4EU+ for Ukraine

The new consortium would develop the cooperation and interoperability in four key pillars:



### Scientific cooperation

More conducive environment for the scientific cooperation, common projects, and inclusion of excellent scientific capacities.

### Education

Mobility of students and professors, development of joint doctoral and other degrees programs, mutual recognition of diplomas, etc.

### Best practices

Sharing the best teaching and training, administrative, procedural and management practices responding to the needs of EaP partner universities.

### The societal role of the university

Opening the dialogue about the role the University can play in the response of the society to the present and future opportunities or challenges.
