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

- Enhanced intercultural competence, global understanding and respect for diversity throughout our communities.

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

# European policy experimentation in higher education: piloting a joint European degree label

- **Duration**: 12 months (starting on 1 March 2023)
- Budget: €200,000 (EU contribution)
- 4 Alliances represented: Arqus, ENLIGHT, EUTOPIA, SEA-EU
- 13 Full partners from 5 countries
- Diverse associate partners: national ministries and quality assurance agencies, European and global university networks, student and alumni associations, along with other partner universities from our four alliances.
