- Be compatible and comparable
- Support transition and access
- Automatically recognized
- Not a catalyst for harmonization



“Students within the alliance should be able to rely on the fact that they can obtain a degree from any of the universities under the same rules and conditions (tuition fee, housing possibilities, support systems, etc.), that the same application and admission procedures will apply and that there will be no differences in recognition of the diploma given by the universities within the alliance.”
