Founded in **1985** the Coimbra Group is an association of **long-established European multidisciplinary universities of high international standard**.

The Coimbra Group is committed to creating special academic and cultural ties in order to promote internationalisation, academic collaboration, excellence in learning and research, and service to society.

It is also the purpose of the Coimbra Group to **influence European education and research policy** and to **develop best practice** through mutual exchange of experience. One of the pioneering actors in the creation of Erasmus+, the co-creation of the European Universities Initiative, and the development of the European Higher Education Area (EHEA).



Facts and figures

- Founded in **1985**
- **40** Universities from **22** European countries
- > 1,4M students / > 232 000 staff members (teaching, research, admin.)
- 14.4% of all signed grants in H2020:
 - 25% of all RIAs, IAs and CSA projects awarded under Pillar II
 - 12.5% of all ERC funded grants
 - 15.5% of all MSCA funded projects
- 21% of all signed grants in HEU:
 - 26% of all RIAs, IAs and CSA projects under Pillar II
 - **11,7% of all ERC** funded grants
 - 20.85% of all MSCA funded projects
- >16% of all Erasmus+ grants to/from CG universities



Executive Board Priorities 2023-2024

- > Drive CG's internal development through new initiatives:
 - Deepening our connection to CG members and the professional communities we represent: 2023-2024 will see the launch of two pilot calls for the allocation of targeted funding to the WGs. This new initiative will also fulfil the longstanding objective to enhance inter-WGs cooperation.
 - Continuing the discussions on the network's future as initiated at the 2023 GA in Cologne: the aim is to reach a consensus on our collective vision ahead of the celebrations of CG's 40th anniversary in 2025. This year the EB will also develop a roadmap on membership enlargement.


- CG is a European Research Area registered stakeholder:

Civic and Societal Engagement


- CG launched the Poitiers Declaration (2016):





Three-Minute Thesis (3MT) Competition

- Since 2015 the Coimbra Group has organised a 3MT competition at network level.
- The 3MT challenges **PhD students** to describe their research to a general audience in English in less than three minutes.
- In 2023, a total of **26 CG universities** took part in this competition by presenting to the CG the winner of their own institutional competition.
- Three finalists are then shortlisted among all winners. They compete during the CG live final taking place at the CG Annual Conference in June.





Scholarship Programmes

Background: Since 1999 the Coimbra Group has offered young researchers from outside the EU the **opportunity** to carry out part of their research for a period of one to three months at a Coimbra Group University.

The CG scholarship programme for short research stays in Europe is intended for young researchers and staff from universities in Latin America, Sub-Saharan Africa and the European Neighbourhood.

2023 Key Figures:

- 74 scholarships awarded (30 LA, 30 Africa, 14 EN)
- **33** ♀ and **41** ♀
- 879 applicants
- **19** CG host universities
