Virtual Exchange Initiatives

Erasmus+ Virtual Exchange

<u>Erasmus+ Virtual Exchange</u> is a ground-breaking project enabling youth in Europe and the Southern Mediterranean to engage in meaningful intercultural experiences online, as part of their formal or non-formal education.

X-Culture

X-Culture is a large-scale international experiential learning project that involves over 3,500 MBA and business students from 100 universities from 40 countries on six continents every semester. The students are placed in global virtual teams of about seven, each student coming from a different country.

Conversifi

Conversifi connects foreign language learners with native speakers for on-demand language practice and cross-cultural exchange over video chat.

Soliva

The Connect Program—Soliya's flagship virtual exchange initiative—is an online cross-cultural education program integrated into curriculum that provides young adults with a unique opportunity to: ... Develop 21st Century skills such as critical thinking, cross-cultural communication, and media literacy.

Sharing Perspectives

The <u>Sharing Perspectives Foundation</u> has developed a Virtual Exchange pedagogy for students at higher education institutions and other youth that promotes discussion and study of current socio-political issues that go beyond national and/or cultural boundaries.

The online language learning tandem project by UNESP - Universidade Estadual Paulista, Brazil.

Cultura

<u>Cultura</u> is an intercultural project that connects groups of students online to help them understand each other's culture. A Cultura exchange is typically based in a language class and involves two partner teachers and two groups of students from two different cultures.
